The season

Start competition

- After the summer holidays of primary school, training will start again and in September the matches will also start (first field season).
- The indoor season starts at the beginning of November
- The second field season starts in April

End of competition

 The last competition weekend is on June 6. After this we will organize a number of fun activities such as the youth camp!

It is possible that trainers deviate from the above dates. The trainer will then communicate this with the team.

Sign out

Preferably not, of course. This year's holidays are listed below. If you really can't make it, you must sign off with the trainer (at least 3 days before the training or match, unless sick).

Whit Monday

On 2nd Pentecost Monday, the 8-players tournament is traditionally organized (teams of 8 people with a maximum of 4 korfball players per team) and a parent-child tournament. Everyone can/may participate (also from outside the association)! Make a note of these in your agenda. Further information will follow in due course.

End of season

Traditionally, the pair shooting tournament takes place at the end of the season. Everyone can/may participate here too!

Short explanation of coupling shooting for those who don't know it: Couple shooting is done with two people, this may be 2 ladies, 2 gentlemen or gentleman and lady (parent and child is of course also allowed). There will be 2 baskets opposite each other at a certain distance. There is a couple on each side. The other couple then takes turns shooting at the basket. If the opponent misses, you may shoot from where the ball lands, provided it has not bounced more than 1x. The winner is the one who has scored the most goals after a certain time. Several matches are played.

The champions will also be honored on this day and the DKB BBQ will take place at the end. Everyone will receive an invitation for this in due course.

Teams

The team classification is announced by the TC for the seniors and by the TCj for the youth. The trainer is the first point of contact for players and parents. In addition, the TCj has a point of contact for questions for each age category.

League 2.0

From the 2025/2026 season, the KNKV has introduced League 2.0. This new setup is intended to better match the fun of playing and the development of players to age, level and experience, so that every child can enjoy playing korfball.

This means that from this season there will be a completely new team layout. The KNKV has stopped with the well-known age categories A, B, C, D, E and F. Instead, there is now a clear split:

- **A-category:** These are the highest classes (formerly competition korfball). These teams are divided into U19, U17 and U15.
- B-category: these are the other teams (formerly broad korfball). They are
 divided into a color category based on the average age of the team. Each
 color has its own rules for, for example, basket height, ball size, playing
 time and substitutions.

Our youth teams season 2025/2026

All our youth teams will play in the B-category this season. This means that they play in one of the color categories:

J1: RedJ2: OrangeJ3: YellowJ4: GreenJ5: Blue

In the diagram below you can see exactly which rules apply per category, such as the basket height, the ball and the playing time. In this way, the game is accessible and educational for the youngest children, and they build up step by step to the 'big' korfball.

Outdoor competition

DKB has its own accommodation with canteen: 'De Uitwijk'. This is where training and home games are played during the field season. There is also a beautiful beach field, which we can use for an activity, open training or adapted training.

Indoor competition

During the indoor competition, training and playing takes place in the hall. Training takes place in different places. This can be in sports hall Naestenbest, in the gymnasiums of Heerbeeck College or one of the other gymnasiums in Best. Where and when training will be announced as soon as the training times are known. Matches are played in sports hall Naestenbest.

Away games

At away games, we play on the field or in the hall of our opponents.

Beach fieldIn addition, we also have a fantastic beach field that can be used as an addition or variation to the training. This field can be used/rented by anyone in the Best of the area. Membership administration

You can register and deregister at the membership administration. You can register online but also via a registration form. You can only unsubscribe by email: ledenadministratie@kvdkb.nl. You can only unsubscribe once a year. If you report your deregistration no later than 1 May, you will be deregistered as of 1 June. If you cancel too late, you will owe the contribution for the coming season. You can also change an address or bank account number via email.

Confidential (contact) person

A confidential contact person initially offers a listening ear in matters that are not easy to talk about. This mainly concerns (sexual) intimidation, bullying and/or violence, but there may also be other matters that you would like to discuss with someone who is independent and who is outside the situation. A confidential contact person listens, gives advice, mediates and knows the possibilities of getting help or making an official report.

Are you in a situation where you could use a confidential contact person? Are you worried about something or someone in the association and do you want to discuss this with someone? Technical Committee (TC)

Responsible for all administrative actions concerning senior teams to and from the KNKV. Within DKB responsible for the optimal performance of the senior teams. Point of contact for technical staff and players. Before, during and after the season.

Technical Committee Youth (TCJ)

The Technical Committee Youth is responsible for the team classification, the training sessions, the trainers and the competitions.

DAKje

The DAKje is a committee that takes care of activities at DKB. Sometimes korfball-related activities such as couple shooting and the 8 tournament. But parties or bingos are also organized. Something fun is thought of for all ages!

Camp committee

Every year at the end of the korfball season, a camp is organized. From the autumn onwards, the camp committee will be busy arranging everything, for a fun weekend for young and old. Meetings, on-site visits and a craft evening. The committee arranges the location, the weekend program with the accompanying games and much more.

Arbitration Committee

The Arbitration Committee is responsible for scheduling, training and supervising our referees. Each match is played under the guidance of a referee. The arbitration committee ensures that this is managed properly.

Bar committee

The bar committee arranges the purchasing and takes care of the bar occupancy in our clubhouse. During match days and during various activities, they provide a warm welcome and that players, parents or other visitors can have a drink and a snack.

Membership recruitment committee

Organizing korfball events for (new) members, making flyers, arranging trainers/supervisors for these activities.

Sponsor committee

The sponsor committee is responsible for recruiting new sponsors and maintaining current contracts. Sufficient sponsors provide an important source of income. The work of the sponsor committee is therefore becoming increasingly important!

Working group G-korfball

At DKB we are proud of our G-team. This is a team suitable for members with a disability or support need. It is a group of fanatical players who train weekly on Tuesday evenings. About once a month we play a tournament against several other associations.

Competition secretariat

The competition secretariat is the first contact to the KNKV and to other associations when it comes to competition matters. Together with TC and TCj, the competition secretariat ensures that all matters related to the competition are arranged: planning matches at the beginning of seasons, rescheduling matches, registering teams and players with the KNKV.

Clothing committee

Collection and distribution of match shirts. Distribution of ordered clothing to members. Suggest new items and contact with supplier

Assist

Under the motto "playing along is helping", all teams are asked to help with the bar service, cleaning the canteen, driving to away games and keeping ushers during the indoor matches. Below is an indication of what this means. This requires a little effort and ensures that not everything comes down to a handful of volunteers.

Bar service

Each team is asked a number of times each field season to help with the bar service. You will receive the planning for this via the team's group app and can be found on www.kvdkb.nl. With all parents together you divide the match day so that there is always someone present to support the bar volunteer. The bar volunteer can help you on your way, if you are new to helping out behind the bar.

Transport to away games

A driving schedule is made for each season. All parents are assigned. When you have to ride as a parent is in the race schedule. Can't drive on a scheduled day? Then you have to take care of the exchange with another parent yourself.

Poetsen kantine

Cleaning the canteen is done every month by a team. You will receive the planning for this via the team's group app and can be found on www.kvdkb.nl. Each team gets a turn once a year. Someone from the board will always be present. He or she will indicate which parts of the canteen need to be cleaned.

Usher

During indoor competitions, a parent is appointed as an usher for the youth. The usher is expected to be present fifteen minutes before the match. There is a table and service from the scoreboard. If you can't figure this out, the trainer can help you with this. Because we are in the hall with time slots, it is the task of the usher to ensure that matches go according to plan as much as possible. In the special case that there is not enough time to complete a match, the usher must consult with the referee regarding the shortening of the match.

Job day

The handyman day takes place 1x a year. Then the green maintenance is carried out, things are repaired and cleaned.

(Competition) clothing and footwear

At DKB we play in black with yellow match clothing. Players wear a black/yellow striped shirt with black shorts/skirt. In addition, shoes adapted to the field or indoor season. On the field, korfball shoes with studs for grip are played with (note: no football shoes). In the hall we play on shoes without studs, suitable for the hall.

The match shirt that our players play in is loaned to the players by the club. When a player will start matches, a shirt can be arranged through the clothing committee. The committee members are Esther Branderhorst and Johan Rijndorp.

The skirt/pants and shoes with socks must be purchased yourself.

Soon, a webshop, through our supplier Sport 2000 Brabant Sports in collaboration with Erima, will go live. At the time of writing this information guide, the webshop is not yet operational, but you will be made aware of this via various media (group app, channel) as soon as this is the case.

BSO in clubhouse

From September 11, 2025, a BSO will be active in the clubhouse. This means that the clubhouse can only be entered after 18.45 because the reception lasts until a little after 18.30. The changing rooms, showers, toilets, taps, etc. can be reached directly via the side entrance. Further house rules will be announced later.

Remaining

Diabetes fund (clothing container)

Do you have old clothes, shoes and/or household textiles left over? Give it a second life and deposit it in sealed bags in the container (immediately to the left after passing through the gate) at DKB. This action is for the Diabetes Fund. Help them fight diabetes! See www.stichting-kovamo.nl



Jantje Beton (collection)

DKB is also committed to Jantje Beton. More than 400,000 children in the Netherlands never play outside. We are in danger of losing a generation to sitting indoors. Too little exercise causes physical problems. No direct contact with other children means that they do not learn social skills. Being alone makes them depressed and anxious. There are too few places where children can play safely outside and that has to change!

DKB will also ask the youth members to participate in the collection in that week, usually during a training evening, but you can also collect all week if you like to do so. With this you support the charity, but DKB is also supported with part of the proceeds. Usually the collection is in March. More info:www.jantjebeton.nl/



Big Club Action

Every year, DKB also participates in the big club action. As a lottery ticket seller, you have a chance to win great prizes and also contribute to the club coffers. How does it work:

If you want to search for DKB via whatsapp itself, first go to the 'updates' tab and there you will find the 'channels' option. 
